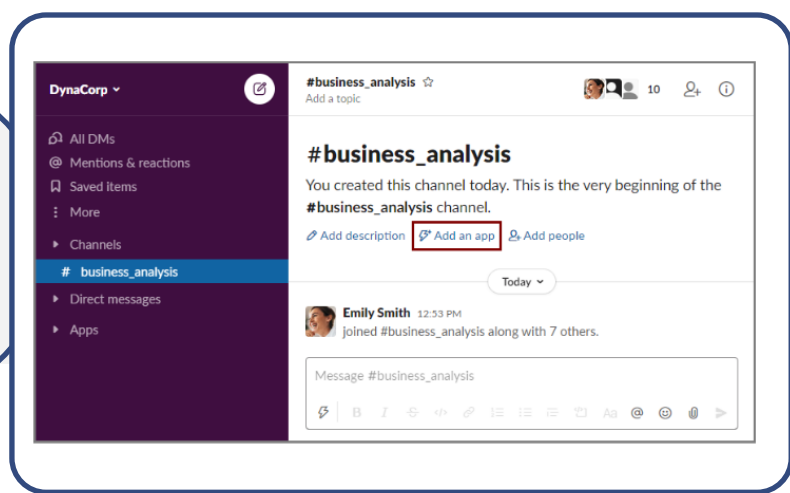

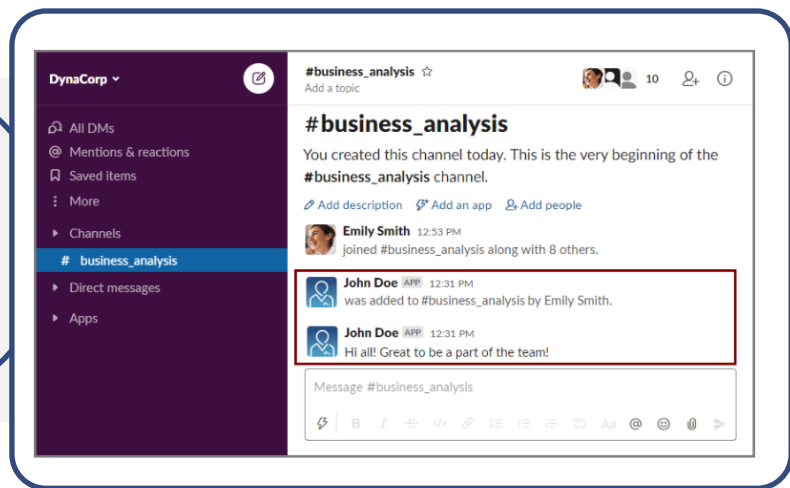

In the list of workspace apps, find your non-Slack contact, e.g., *john.doe@gomaxine.com*, and click **Add**.

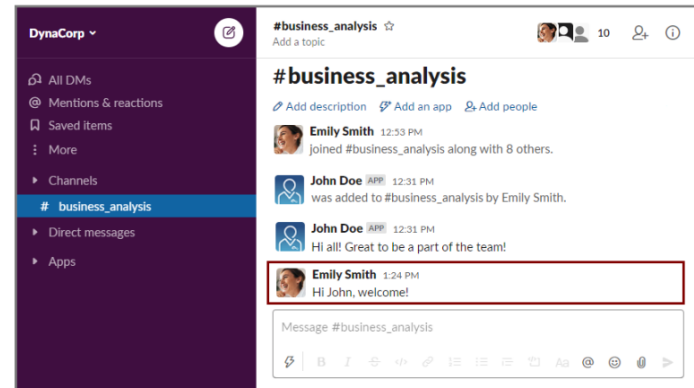
Wait for the non-Slack contact to accept your invitation and join the channel.

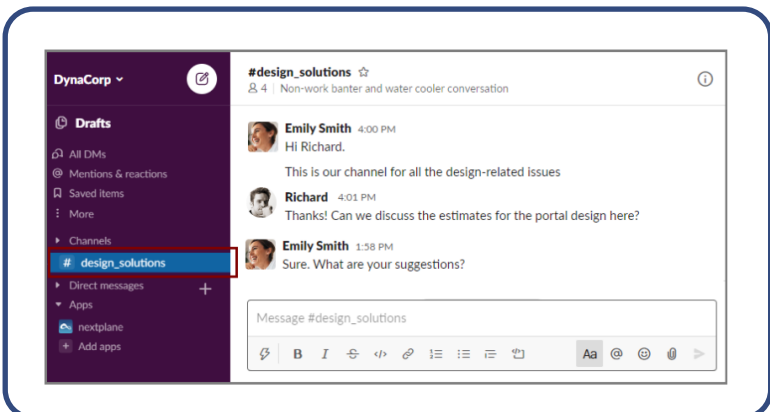

Add non-Slack Contacts to an Existing Slack Channel

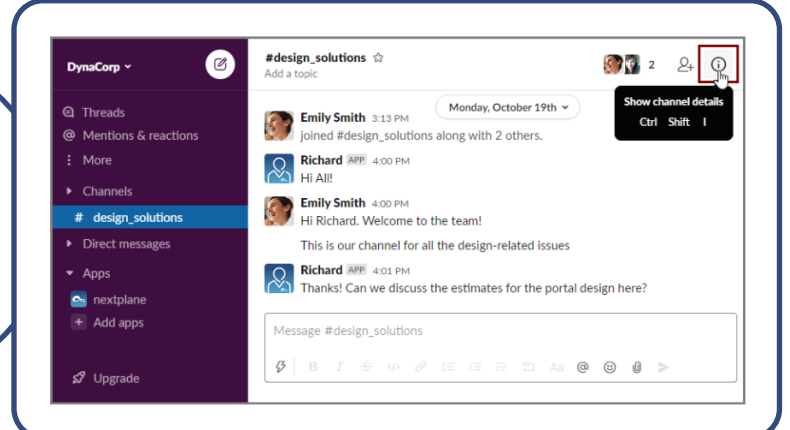

Select the channel that you want to add a non-Slack contact to.



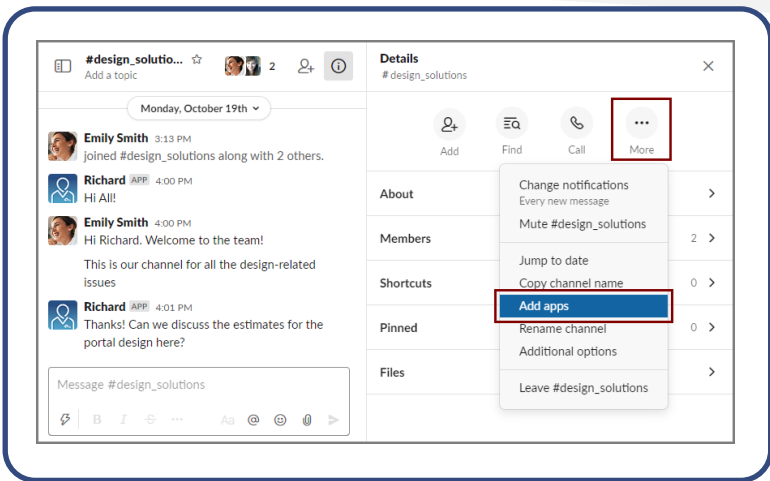
In the upper-right corner, click **Show channel details**.

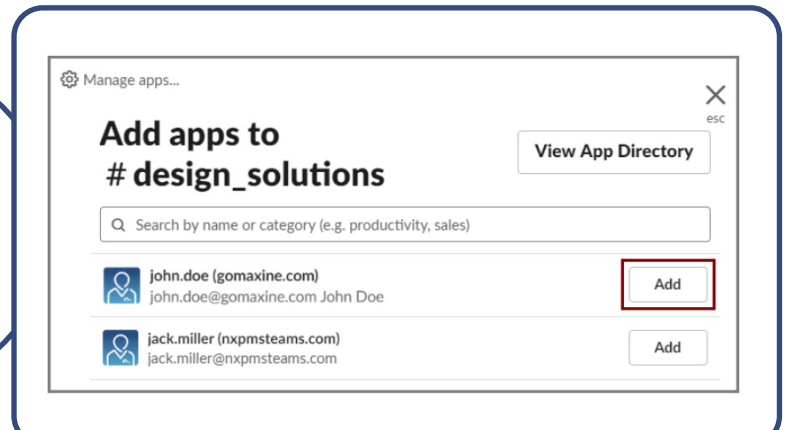

Select **More > Add apps**.



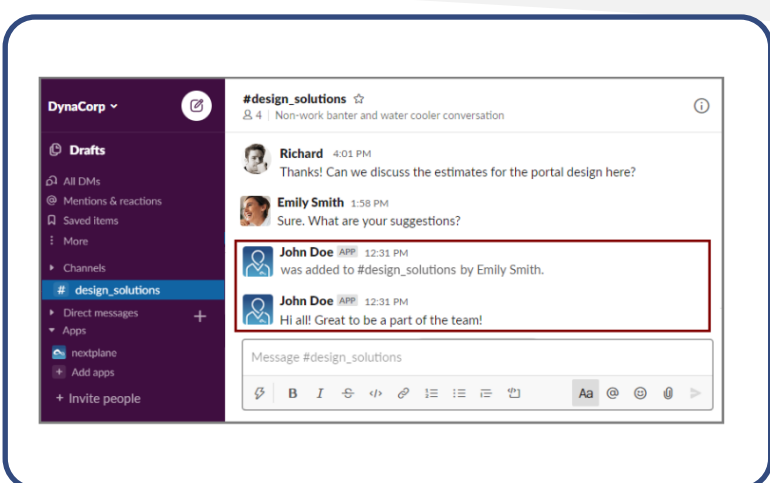
In the list of workspace apps, next to the app representing the necessary contact, click **Add**.
